Nature of the work: Observation of groundworks for three new interpretation panels.

Reason for condition: The site is located within the Gosbecks Archaeological Park, an Iron Age and Romano-British site of national significance (Scheduled monument 10002180).

% of total seen: 100% of the groundworks were monitored by a CAT archaeologist

Results: Three small rectangular holes were excavated to a depth of 0.45m through turf, topsoil and buried topsoil. Groundworks were too small and shallow to impact any archaeological remains.

Panel 1 (Temple): A small rectangular hole, 0.6m by 0.45m and 0.45m deep, was cut through turf (L1, 0.06m thick) and topsoil (L2, 0.37m thick, mid brown silty-loam) into buried topsoil (L3, brown silty-loam).

Panel 2 (Theatre): A small rectangular hole, 0.55m by 0.35m and 0.45m deep, was cut through turf (L1, 0.08m thick) into topsoil (L2).

Panel 3 (Olivers Lane entrance): A small rectangular hole, 0.55m by 0.4m and 0.45m deep, was cut through turf (L1, 0.08m thick) into topsoil (L2).
